- ◇ God created the earth and created life,
- ◇ **Genesis 1**
- ◇ God made "Humanity" (Man) in His Image.. We are models of God
- ◇ He gave man Dominion over the earth


Gen 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Gen 1:27 So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Gen 1:31 And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, *it was* very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

Gen 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

Gen 2:25 And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

- ◆ Genesis 3: Satan (Adversary)
Lucifer & 1/3 of the angels fell before the fall of man
- ◆ Permitted to test Adam & Eve obedience through the Serpent
- ◆ Adam and Eve accept the Serpents offer... The Fall... All of Creation fell with Humanity
- ◆ Why did all creation fall?
- ◆ God promised Redemption and Judgment

- ◆ (13) Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this that you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."
- ◆ (14) The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, cursed are you above all livestock and above all beasts of the field; on your belly you shall go, and dust you shall eat all the days of your life."
- ◆ (15) I will put **enmity** between **you** and the **woman**, and between your offspring and her offspring; **he shall bruise your head**, and **you shall bruise his heel.**"

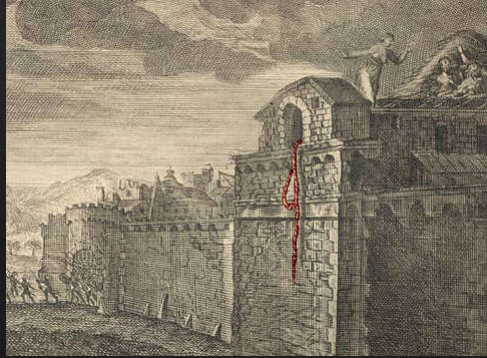
Gen 49:1-2
 (1) Then Jacob called his sons and said,
 "Gather yourselves together, that I may tell
 you what shall happen to you in days to come.
 (2) "Assemble and listen, O sons of Jacob,
 listen to Israel your father.



- ◇ Jacob has 12 Sons
- ◇ 12 Sons become 12 Tribes
- ◇ The Promise to Judah
- ◇ (10) The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until **Shiloh** come; and unto him *shall* the gathering of the people *be*.
- ◇ *Shiloh* = *Messiah*

- ◆ David is Anointed
- ◆ 1Samuel 16:1
- ◆ (1) The LORD said to Samuel, "How long will you grieve over Saul, since I have rejected him from being king over Israel? Fill your horn with oil, and go. I will send you to Jesse the **Bethlehemite**, for I have provided for myself a king among his sons."
- ◆ 1Sa 16:12-13
- ◆ (12) And he sent and brought him in. Now he was ruddy and had beautiful eyes and was handsome. And **the LORD said, "Arise, anoint him, for this is he."**
- ◆ (13) Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers. And **the Spirit of the LORD rushed upon David** from that day forward. And Samuel rose up and went to Ramah.

- ◇ Nathan reveals God's Plan for David
- ◇ David's Son would have an everlasting Throne
- ◇ 2Sa 7:4-5
- ◇ (4) But that same night the word of the LORD came to Nathan,
- ◇ (5) "Go and tell my servant David, 'Thus says the LORD: Would you build me a house to dwell in?'"
- ◇ 2Sa 7:12-14
- ◇ (12) When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and **I will establish his kingdom.**
- ◇ (13) He shall build a house for my name, and **I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.**
- ◇ (14) I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men,

- ◇ Forever Kingdom—Throne of David
- ◇ Messianic Kingdom
- ◇ **Isaiah 9:6-7**
- ◇ (6) For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
- ◇ (7) Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

Isa 11:5 Righteousness shall be the belt of his waist, and faithfulness the belt of his loins.

Isa 11:6 The wolf shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the young goat, and the calf and the lion and the fattened calf together; and a little child shall lead them. |

Isa 11:7 The cow and the bear shall graze; their young shall lie down together; and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

Isa 11:8 The nursing child shall play over the hole of the cobra, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the adder's den.

Isa 11:9 They shall not hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain; for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD as the waters cover the sea.

- ◇ Mat 1:1-4
- ◇ (1) The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, **the son of David**, the **son of Abraham**.
- ◇ (2) Abraham was the father of Isaac, and Isaac the father of Jacob, and Jacob the father of Judah and his brothers,
- ◇ (3) and Judah the father of Perez and Zerah by Tamar, and Perez the father of Hezron, and Hezron the father of Ram,
- ◇ (4) and Ram the father of Amminadab, and Amminadab the father of Nahshon, and Nahshon the father of Salmon,

- ◇ Mat 1:5-9
- ◇ (5) and Salmon the father of Boaz by **Rahab**, and Boaz the father of Obed by **Ruth**, and Obed the father of Jesse,
- ◇ (6) and Jesse the father of David the king. And David was the father of Solomon by the **wife of Uriah**,
- ◇ (7) and Solomon the father of Rehoboam, and Rehoboam the father of Abijah, and Abijah the father of Asaph,
- ◇ (8) and Asaph the father of Jehoshaphat, and Jehoshaphat the father of Joram, and Joram the father of Uzziah,

- ◇ Mat 1:10-13
- ◇ (10) and Hezekiah the father of Manasseh, and Manasseh the father of Amos, and Amos the father of Josiah,
- ◇ (11) and Josiah the father of Jechoniah and his brothers, at the time of the deportation to Babylon.
- ◇ (12) And after the deportation to Babylon: Jechoniah was the father of Shealtiel, and Shealtiel the father of Zerubbabel,
- ◇ (13) and Zerubbabel the father of Abiud, and Abiud the father of Eliakim, and Eliakim the father of Azor,

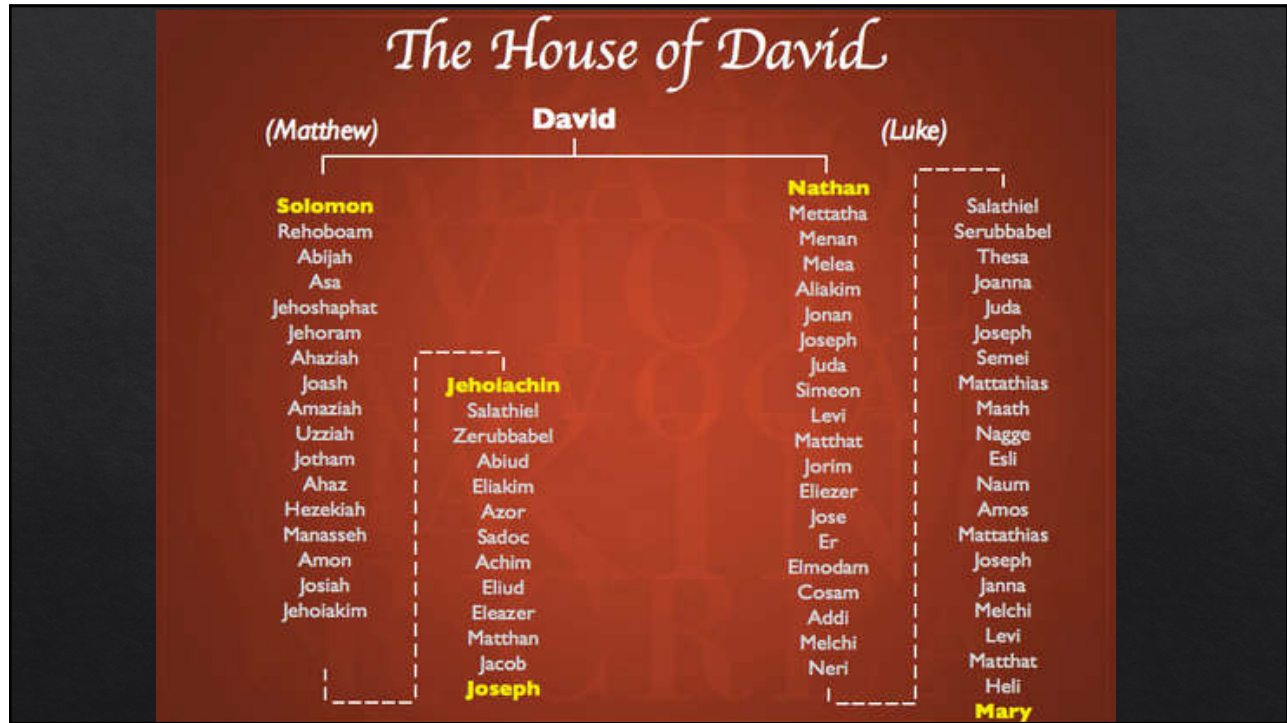

- ◇ Mat 1:14-17
- ◇ (14) and Azor the father of Zadok, and Zadok the father of Achim, and Achim the father of Eliud,
- ◇ (15) and Eliud the father of Eleazar, and Eleazar the father of Matthan, and Matthan the father of Jacob,
- ◇ (16) and Jacob the father of Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ.
- ◇ (17) So all the generations from Abraham to David were fourteen generations, and from David to the deportation to Babylon fourteen generations, and from the deportation to Babylon to the Christ fourteen generations.

- ◇ Mat 1:18-20
- ◇ (18) Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit.
- ◇ (19) And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly.
- ◇ (20) But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.

- ◇ Mat 1:22-25
- ◇ (22) All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet:
- ◇ (23) "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us).
- ◇ (24) When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife,
- ◇ (25) but knew her not until she had given birth to a son. And he called his name Jesus.

Mat 2:1-3

- (1) Now after Jesus was born in **Bethlehem** of Judea in the days of **Herod the king**, behold, **wise men from the east came to Jerusalem**,
- (2) saying, "Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him."
- (3) When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him;

Mic 5:1 Now muster your troops, O daughter of troops; siege is laid against us; with a rod they strike the judge of Israel on the cheek.

Mic 5:2 But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days.

Mat 2:4-6

(4) and assembling all the chief priests and scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born.

(5) They told him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for so it is written by the prophet:

(6) "'And you, O Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for from you shall come a ruler who will shepherd my people Israel.'"

Mat 2:7-9

(7) Then Herod summoned the wise men secretly and ascertained from them what time the star had appeared.

(8) And he sent them to Bethlehem, saying, "Go and search diligently for the child, and when you have found him, bring me word, that I too may come and worship him."

(9) After listening to the king, they went on their way. And behold, the star that they had seen when it rose went before them until it came to rest over the place where the child was.

Mat 2:10-13

(10) When they saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly with great joy.

(11) And going into the house they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him **gifts, gold and frankincense and myrrh.**

(12) And being warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed to their own country by another way.

(13) Now when they had departed, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, "Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there until I tell you, for Herod is about to search for the child, to destroy him."

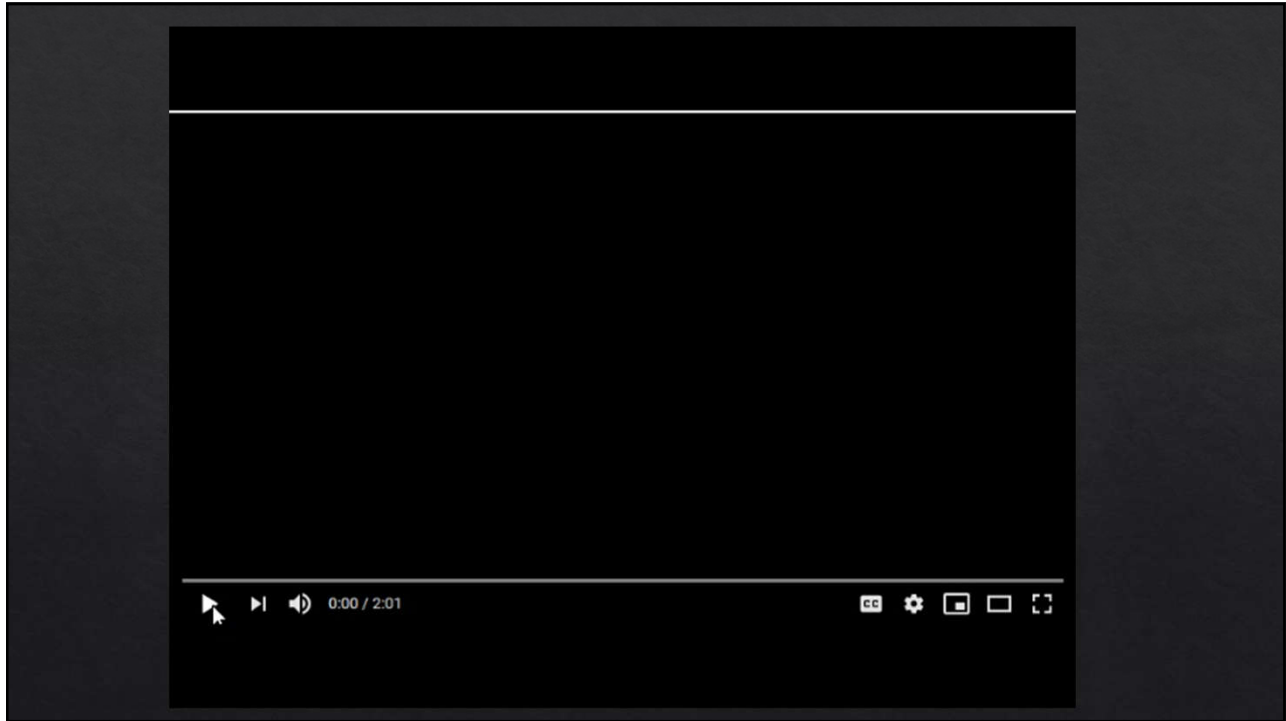

Mat 2:14 And he rose and took the child and his mother by night and departed to Egypt

Mat 2:15 and remained there until the death of Herod. This was to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet, "Out of Egypt I called my son."

Mat 2:16 Then Herod, when he saw that he had been tricked by the wise men, became furious, and **he sent and killed all the male children in Bethlehem and in all that region who were two years old or under,** according to the time that he had ascertained from the wise men.

Mat 2:17-23



(17) Then was fulfilled what was spoken by the **prophet Jeremiah**:

(18) "A voice was heard in Ramah, weeping and loud lamentation, Rachel weeping for her children; she refused to be comforted, because they are no more."

(19) But when Herod died, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt,

(20) saying, "**Rise, take the child and his mother and go to the land of Israel**, for those who sought the child's life are dead."

Jer 31:15 Thus says the LORD: "A voice is heard in Ramah, lamentation and bitter weeping. Rachel is weeping for her children; she refuses to be comforted for her children, because they are no more."

Mat 2:17-23

(21) And he rose and took the child and his mother and went to the land of Israel.

(22) But when he heard that Archelaus was reigning over Judea in place of his father Herod, he was afraid to go there, and being warned in a dream he withdrew to the **district of Galilee**.

(23) And he went and lived in a city called Nazareth, so that what was spoken by the prophets might be fulfilled, that he would be called a Nazarene.
