




- (4) but the wise took flasks of oil with their lamps.




- (24) Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands.

- ♦ (30) because we are members of his body.







- *(13) Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour.








Mat 25:31-35

(31) "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne.

(32) Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.

(33) And he will place the sheep on his right, but the goats on the left.

(35) For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink,





44 Mat 25:42-46 (42) For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, (43) I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not clothe me, sick and in prison and you did not visit me.' (44) Then they also will answer, saying, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to you?' (10) But Jesus, aware of this, said to them, "Why do you trouble the woman? For she has done a beautiful thing to me.

(11) For you always have the poor with you, but you will not always have me.

(12) In pouring this ointment on my body, she has done it to prepare me for burial.

(13) Truly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is proclaimed in the whole world, what she has done will also be told in memory of her."


(52) The tombs also were opened. And many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised,

♦ Mat 27:61-66 Preparation Day—Preparing for the Passover...14th of Nisan ♦ (61) Mary Magdalene and the other Mary were there, sitting opposite the tomb. ♦ (62) The next day, that is, after the day of Preparation, the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered before Pilate (63) and said, "Sir, we remember how that impostor said, while he was still alive, 'After three days I will rise.' (64) Therefore order the tomb to be made secure until the third day, lest his disciples go and steal him away and tell the people, 'He has risen from the dead,' and the last fraud will be worse than the first." (65) Pilate said to them, "You have a guard of soldiers. Go, make it as secure as you can." (66) So they went and made the tomb secure by sealing the stone and setting a guard.

(1) Now after the Sabbath, toward the dawn of the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the tomb.


(2) And behold, there was a great earthquake, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled back the stone and sat on it.

(10) Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee, and there they will see me."

Mat 28:11-15

(11) While they were going, behold, some of the guard went into the city and told the chief priests all that had taken place.

(12) And when they had assembled with the elders and taken counsel, they gave a sufficient sum of money to the soldiers

(13) and said, "Tell people, 'His disciples came by night and stole him away while we were asleep.'

(14) And if this comes to the governor's ears, we will satisfy him and keep you out of trouble."

(15) So they took the money and did as they were directed. And this story has been spread among the Jews to this day.
